PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A:

Currently, the Wyoming Constitution allows the legislature to authorize the investment of public employee retirement systems funds and permanent state funds in equities, such as stock or shares in private or public companies. Permanent funds of the state include funds designated as permanent funds by the Constitution. The Wyoming Constitution does not allow the state to invest any other funds in equities. The adoption of this amendment would allow the legislature, by two-thirds vote of the members of both houses, to authorize the investment of additional specified state funds in equities.

BALLOT PROPOSITION

LODGING TAX OPTION:

Shall the City of Kemmerer, Lincoln County, State of Wyoming, continue to impose an additional 4% lodging tax upon the sales price paid for lodging services for the primary purpose of promoting local travel and tourism? This tax will be imposed for four (4) years.

Shall the Town of Diamondville continue to impose an additional 2% sales tax upon the sales price paid for lodging services, the primary purpose of which is for the promotion of local travel and tourism? This tax will be imposed for four (4) years.

Shall the Town of Cokeville continue to impose an additional 2% sales tax upon the sales price paid for lodging services, the primary purpose of which is for the promotion of local travel and tourism? This tax will be imposed for four (4) years.

CAMPAIGN FILING REQUIREMENTS

November 1, 2016 - Statement of Contributions report due

November 18, 2016 - Statement of Contributions and Expenditures report due

EVERY candidate, whether successful or not, must file **BOTH** campaign reports.

This includes candidates who neither receive nor spend any money during the campaign. Candidates or committees who fail to file the required reports within the stipulated time are subject to civil and other penalties. A candidate who fails to file the Statement of Receipts required by the 7th day before the election will have his/her name printed on a list that will be made available to the public. In addition, a candidate who fails to file the statement required under W.S. 22-25-106 within 30 days of the report due date is ineligible to run as a candidate for any state or local office for which a statement is required until five years have elapsed from the date the statement was first due, or until the required statement has been filed. ***This section does not apply to special district candidates.***

If you require assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability or inability to read or write, you may be given assistance by a person of your choice. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact the County Clerk's Office.

Absentee ballots may be requested through **November 7, 2016**.
