

**NEW STATE STATUTE THAT EFFECTS
REGISTERED CAMPERS OR TRAVEL TRAILERS**

(For Example, 5th wheel camp trailer, livestock trailers with living quarters, or toy hauler with living quarters)

As of January 1, 2015, there will be changes regarding the state fees on all new and current travel trailer plates registered in Wyoming (per Wyoming State Statute 31-3-101).

Presently, the state fee on all travel trailers is \$15.00. At the beginning of 2015, **the state fee amount will vary depending on the WEIGHT of the travel trailer**, just like all other types of trailers that are currently registered in Wyoming. If you currently have a travel trailer licensed, after the first of the year the fees may change at the time of renewal, depending on the weight.

The renewal cards you receive will reflect this new fee. We are currently sending out corrected renewal cards for January and February of 2015.

Because we currently don't have the weights of your registered campers or travel trailers, we are attempting to use various guidelines to determine this. **If you feel that your trailer doesn't fit into these guidelines**, please feel free to have your trailer weighed at any local weighing station and present us with the weight slip, or look inside the door of your trailer, take a snapshot of it, and bring it in when you renew. We are attempting to get the correct weights on all the trailers that we register.
